Q: Are beatitudes short for bad attitudes?

A: Jesus taught a short sermon called the Beatitudes to describe good attitudes, the attitudes that God wants us to have. The word *beatitude* means "blessed." Jesus said that whoever followed him should be poor in spirit, merciful, honest, and should expect rejection from others for being his follower. Jesus' disciples may have been thinking that they would become rich, famous, and powerful by following him, but Jesus was telling them that they should expect their rewards in heaven.

Key Verses: One day, Jesus looked out and saw the crowds around him. So he went up the hillside with his disciples. He sat down and taught them there. (Matthew 5:1-2)
